The DSIS 5th grade art program this year is an introductory course for 6 weeks. The course is designed to provide a foundation of art terminology, skills, techniques, concepts, and problem-solving skills. Students will produce two- and three-dimensional art projects, discuss, and write about their own art and that of other artists. Student art will give students an opportunity to develop skills/techniques, express imaginative ideas, and explore symbolism. You can find some of the topics covered in this class on the back of this page.

Behavior Expectations:

All students must follow all school and classroom rules. If a student chooses not to follow our behavior expectations, I will follow the discipline hierarchy of our campus

Supplies:

Students will create a daily art journal in class. This will stay in the art room. This is where we will add our sketchbook exercises, notes, and plans for projects.

Students bring a PENCIL/ERASER to class daily. Please leave binders and backpacks in lockers/core classes.

Course Schedule:

All assignments will be completed in class. Parents will be notified if any assignments need to be prepared outside of class.

Late Work Policy:

Teacher will accept late work:

- 1 class day late – grade reduced by 10 points
- 2 class days late – grade reduced by 20 points
- 3 class days late – Maximum grade of 70

Test Re-take Policy

Students who fail a **major test/project** (below 70%) will be allowed to make corrections for a maximum grade of 70%. All corrections must be completed by the specified date given by the teacher unless the student is afforded time, as a result of the district's absent/make-up guidelines.

Missed Work

Students may make-up assignments after an excused absence. Students will have the same number of days they are absent to make up work. Please make sure your child speaks with me after an absence to identify any assignments that need to be completed.

Grading Policy:

Students are graded in art class based on projects, and participation. Students will not have homework in art class. Students will obtain a minimum of one grade per week.

Number of Grades Each Grading Period:
8 (minimum)

Grades will be based upon the following categories:

- 50% - Daily Assignments
- 40% - Major Tests/Projects
- 10% - Homework

Teachers shall determine student progress using a grading scale of 0-100.

90-100 = A

80-89 = B

70-79 = C

Below 70 = Failing

I = Incomplete ("I" is not an academic grade, but indicates incomplete work.)

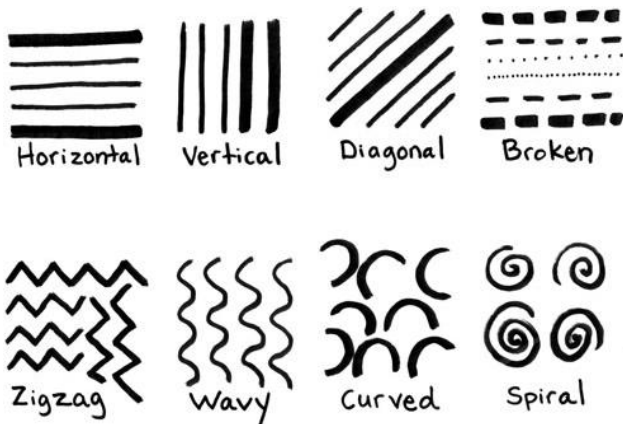

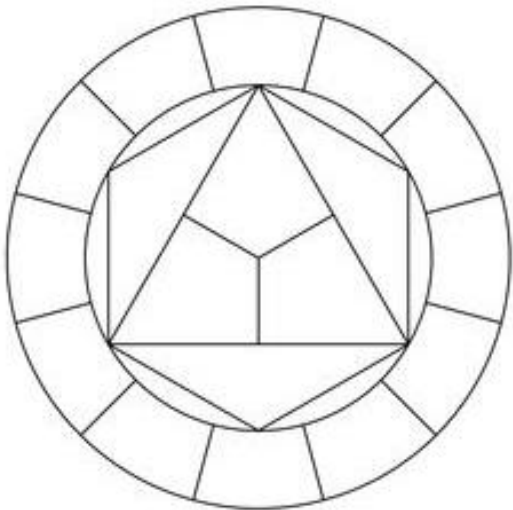

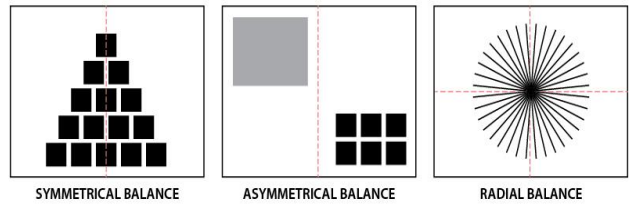
Types of Line



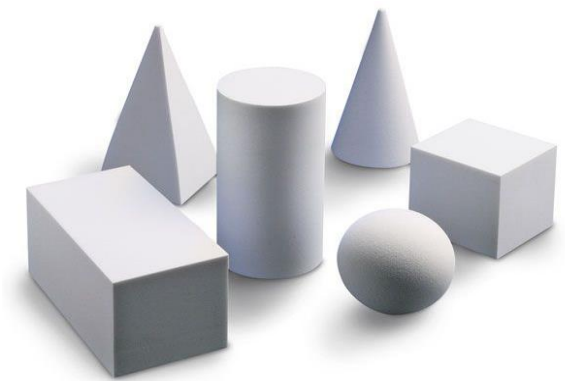
Color Wheel (including primary, secondary, and intermediate colors; warm/cool colors)
