Course Calendar/Schedule:
Follow regular school calendar
Course Policies:
Attendance - Regular school attendance is essential for students to gain the maximum benefit from teacher-led and school activities.

Materials:
Notebook, pencils, red pen
Class Participation:
Active participation, with consideration of each student's skill set, will be expected in all activities.

Missed Exams/Assignments:
Students can makeup assignments or tests after excused absences.
Late Work- First day late - minus 15 points
Second day- late - minus 30 point
Third day late - at teacher's discretion

Grading:

Teachers shall determine academic student progress using a grade percentage scale of $0-100$. Citizenship grades are measured on a Likehart scale (ESNU). 10 grades per 6 weeks is required.

Grade Categories
Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies:

- $50 \%$ - Daily Assignments/Quizzes (minimum of 2 grades per grading period)
- $40 \%$ - Major Tests/Projects*(minimum of 2 grades per grading period)
- $10 \%$ - Homework ( - minimum of 2 grades per grading period)
*District Curriculum-Based Assessments (CBAs) are calculated as part of the Major Grades/Projects
category.
Homework Intermediate schools will provide for homework-free extended holidays. (Thanksgiving Break, Winter Break, and Spring Break)

Semester Grades Semester grades are computed by averaging the numerical grades recorded for each of the three grading periods within the semester. The three grading periods will equal $100 \%$ of the student's grade ( $33.3 \%$ per grading period). Credit is awarded at the end of the academic year. *No semester exams are administered at the intermediate level.
"No Pass/No Play" Policy at Icenhower • Students that are not passing a class will need to attend a study hall in order to bring their grades up instead of participating in recess or Fun Fridays. - Students who are not passing a class will not be eligible to represent the school in clubs and athletic events. - Students who are failing a class are ineligible for school socials.

Posting Student Work - Student grades will be posted in Skyward parent portal within five business days for daily grades and major grades. Special consideration is given to major projects, including lengthy writing assignments

Test Re-Take Policy:

- Students who fail a major test/assessment (below 70\%) will be allowed to retake or correct for a maximum grade of $70 \%$. All retakes or corrections must be completed prior to the end of each six week grading period.
- Students are encouraged to attend tutorials.

Tardies and Absences:
Students who are tardy or absent from school are responsible for the classwork / assignments for that day.
